I have searched the Marriage and Death Notices from the Raleigh Register and North Carolina State Gazette, but apparently they did not publish in 1816, the probable marriage year of Willis and wife #1. Your suggestions will be very much appreciated.

SINGLETARY LEGENDS:

There are two legends in the Singletary-Dunham Family. One, recited more fully in the Singletary-Curtis Book, tells of the missing Donham heir kidnapped by his nurse in the pay of the other branch of the Donham Family, so that the other branch would inherit the estate. Some Colonial Records show "---Singletary, alias Donham---" There are reports of a Singletary, fleeing religious persecution, changing his name to Dunham, and Dunham-Singletary marriages are on record. I think our Richard of 1638 in Mass. may be the son of the missing Donham heir, if any.

The second legend is of two Dunnam-Donham-Denham-DuNoe-DuNom brothers, Huguenot refugees from La Rochelle, France, who came to America in early 1700's. Later one slipped back to France to see what he could recover of the Family estates. Upon his return to America he announced to his brother that all was lost--the Crown and the Church had got it all. The unbelieving brother denounced the rascality of the returnee's report and refused to bear the family name any longer, taking his mother's family name--Singletary.

There is much to question in either legend. But--can anyone document either?

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAKING A GENEALOGICAL "STACK"

The purpose of a "Stack" is merely to sort out lines of descent.

Individuals in a stack must be fully identified by genealogical data available, so that they may not be confused with other similar names. Start with oldest individual or family group.

Numbers assigned to generations. These numbers do not carry-over to other stacks or other lines of descent. These numbers are not identification-numbers for individuals.

Spouse(s) should be shown where known. Birth, marriage, and death years should be shown if available. States where individuals lived should be shown, if possible.

Referring to the question raised in Bulletin of 8-15-72 about the ancestry of Susannah Cook m. Richard Singletary 1638. CSA #25 of CA has contributed the following: "The Newbury, Ma., Death Record in 1638 of a female Singletary indicates (1) he immigrated with his mother who died in 1638, OR his wife died in 1638 and he later married Susannah Cook, and that she came with her family or alone." "Susannah Cook does not seem to have come with the Mayflower Cooks--or later as some of that family did--but there is still a possibility." "Francis Cooke (1577-1633) woolcomber of Blyth, Notts. MAYFLOWER Company. In Amsterdam 1607 Leyden 1609-20, Purchaser 1626. Died Plymouth, Puritan. (Franklin Delano Roosevelt was one of his descendants)" "Arriving on the Anne in July-August of 1623 were his wife Hester (Mayhieu) (c.1592-1675). Walloon. m. Leyden c. 1613. With her these children: Jane (c.1615-1666) married Plymouth c. 1638 Experience Mitchell who died at Bridgewater, 7 children. Hester (c.1616-1666) m. Plymouth 1644 Richard Wright, son of William. 3 children. Jacob (1618-1675) married (1) 1646 Damaris Hopkins. m. (2) Mrs. Elizabeth (Lettice) Shurtleff. 6 children" "John Cook (1612-1695) m. 1634 Sarah Warren (who came on the Anne (see above) with her mother Mrs. Elizabeth (March) Warren to join her father Richard Warren, who was a non-puritan on the MAYFLOWER...5 children." "Cooke, Margaret, Boston 1630. Cooke, Aaron, Dorset, a minor c. 1630" "Susan Cooke executed for witchcraft in Worcestershire, Eng. 1649" Surely she is not of our line. Ahem! Mrs. Saunders contributed several pages of notes on the early Singletary's which confirm data in Stack with Bulletin of 8-15-72. The following additions therein are indicated: Richard died Oct. 25, 1687, reputedly 102 years old. Susannah wife of Richard died April 11, 1682. Draw a line from left edge between lines 8 and 9, write thereon in left margin "Insert 1". On a blank page which you will always keep at the back of your file of this Stack, write: "Insert 1: Nathaniel and Sarah (Belknap) Singletary had a son, Jonathan, d. Nov. 24, 1678" Similarly, between lines 7 and 8, Insert 2: Eunice b. 7, 11th month, 1641 (Old Style) which converts to February 1642 (New Style). Similarly, between lines 1 and 2, Insert 3: Jonathan b. 17, 11th month, 1639 (February 1640). Such other notes as Mrs. Saunders gave were posted to my index and their effects will appear in the continuation of the Stack, part of which is attached. CSA #5 has again contributed a ream of notes which have been indexed and are reflected in the continuation of the Stack.

Add: #45 George Lennon, Route 2, Lambertton, Minn. 56152. He is descended from Sarah Singletary (dau. Joshua) who m. William Lewis, and incidentally also from HAWES. Her husband is a descendant of Mrs. Nancy (---) Singletary (c.1790-) SC, whose dau. Ann Caroline Singletary m. Thomas H. Smith, who d. Fla. Their dau. Martha Frances Smith m. Samuel Pryor Smith 1880 Fla. Can anyone help her? These two have received everything to date.

COUSINS OF SINGLETARY ANCESTRY--Bulletin #4--4-9-73

In early January we noted with regret the passing of Don J. Singletary of Fort Worth at age 60. Executive officer of Church Loan Association and Baptist Church Loan Corporation, a Trustee of Southwestern Baptist Seminary, he had brought honor to the Singletary name as Bank Officer, Sunday School Teacher, Deacon, and member of numerous church committees. Of which branch of the family we do not know, but we may all walk a little taller because of his life.

CSA #42 brings to our attention that Richard Singletary of Marlborough (Page 8, line 45, of Main Singletary Stack) d. 17 August 1707. And Eunice Singletary (1642-) Ma. m. 1658/9 Thomas Eaton (his 2nd) Page 1 Line 7, Main Singletary Stack, d. Haverhill, Ma. 5 October 1715. As the Singletary-Curtis Book is quite reticent about this line, there may be searchers interested in it who do not know where to find a fuller report. CSA #42 is a descendant of Eunice. Where you indicated Insert 2 between lines 8 and 9, Page 1, now add Insert 4, and on your list of Inserts behind the Stack, show: Insert 4: "Eunice (Singletary) Eaton died Haverhill, Ma. 5 October 1715"

Corrections to Page 11, Main Singletary Stack, CSA Bulletin of January, 1974:

(1) Lines 1, 2, seem to be unchallenged. Line 3: My sources seem to have copied from SAVAGE. Line 4 is vigorously challenged by CSA 9, 7, and 16. SC Book says, Page 20 "Fourth Generation (continued) John Singletary (second son of Benjamin son of Richard m. Sarah Warnock about 1750" I believe it should have said "Fifth Generation (continued) John Singletary son of Joseph son of Benjamin son of Richard..." Let's go back to a "Fourth Generation" previously mentioned and herein (Page 20) to be continued: Such a "Fourth Generation (continued)" is found on Page 15. It starts with "Joseph, youngest son of Benjamin son of Richard" and he was born 1692/3 (Page 13.) His brother John was born 1686. Now this Joseph on Page 15 (youngest son of Benjamin son of Richard) had his oldest child born about 1720 and named for his father Benjamin. His second child was John b. about 1722 and old enough to marry in 1750. Joseph's (of Page 15) last child was born 1723/4 and married 1745, about five years before our questioned John (Page 20, his uncle) is supposed to have married Sarah Warnock (according to S-C Book). We have reason to suspect confusion here!

Now for evidence other than S-C Book: Sarah Margaret Warnock m. John (1726-1791) SC was dau. Joseph and Mary (Hayes) Warnock (Sarah Margaret (1734-1793+) SC. This according to CSA #7 (her work is quite accurate, ERH). Furthermore VIRKUS (admittedly unreliable, but sometimes right) Vol. V. Page 722, says Mary Singletary m. 1783 William Capens (1755-1812) was dau. John (1726-) and Sarah Margaret (Warnock) Singletary, and that John (1726-) was son of Richard (-1716) and Sarah (Stewart) Singletary, s. Benjamin and Mary (Stockbridge) Singletary. I admit that VIRKUS is wrong in this last, since Richard m. Sarah Stewart did not (according to SC Book) have a son named John.

Furthermore, South Carolina Historical Magazine Vo. 58, Page 84, says Sarah Margaret Warnock m. John Singletary (1726-1791).

Benjamin s. Richard¹ had no grandsons named John, except Joseph's (Benjamin's youngest) boy, b. about 1722, according to SC Book. Now note on Page 21 "Fifth Generation(continued) Thomas, third son of Joseph (s. of Benjamin son of Richard" as tho the author was following a second

on of Joseph.

Therefore, John m. Warnock was perhaps son of Joseph, but not of Benjamin son of Richard¹.

CSA#9 reports that Miss Capers' records show that John m. Warnock was son of Broughton Singletary. There is a Broughton on Page 13 of the SC Book, b. 1689. He may have been expected to marry c. 1710/25 and to produce a child in 1726. He m. Deborah Fewilling. CSA 7 says Braton Singletary and Deborah Fewilling Singletary m. 15 Dec. 1711 had a daughter Mary b. 20 Feb. 1712/13, 14 months later. This was in St. Thomas and St. Dennis Parish Records of 1693-1794 Protestant Episcopal Church Page 27, South Caroliniana Library, MS Room. Brayton also had a son Benjamin who sold land to Benjamin son of Jose (Jese) in 1817. but this is another generation. There was a Brayton (-1790) NC (brother of Benjamin) m. Mary, but he cannot be Broughton (1689-) s. Benjamin s. Richard¹, as he had no brother Benjamin, according to S-C Book Furthermore Brayton (-1790) and Mary are not reported to have had a John. There was a Braton (1795-1849+) NC, Ga. who m. Nipsy, but they too are not reported to have a John.

Now there was a Braton father of John in NC, but we do not have documents there either as to time or parentage.

There was a John (-1826) in SC, son of Sarah Singletary, who was a cousin of Elam T. Mills and was father of Martha m. James Dickey, and grandfather of Sophronia Perris Singletary, but his ancestry is not given. We must await further documentation. Meanwhile I have revised Page 11 of the Main Singletary Stack, copy attached. Indexers, please correct your cards.

Please understand that the intent in publishing the Main Singletary Stack is to "put our cards on the table". It is not intended to mean that "here is the final word" in authenticity, nor in information. It is hoped that the publication will lead to members and others offering additional data and we shall come to "inserts on inserts on inserts" which will formalize our knowledge of the family, for all searchers.

CSA ASK: CSA 47 asks help on parents of Berulainen "Penny" Singletary m. 1833 Jeremiah Easterling (1799-) SC, parents Enos (1833-, William (1836-, and James B. Easterling (1840- . Also on Benjamin Singletary (1810-) SC. m. Susannah O'Day Ruby Easterling (1818-) f. Benjamin (1854-, Rebecca Jane (1835, Elizabeth M. (1838-, Eliza Ann "Ketuch" (1840, Mary Jane (1844-, Lydia Anne (1846, and Ellen V. Singletary (1849-). Berulainen may be misreading of Berul (Beryl) Anne and we have a Beryl Ann (-1972-) dau. John Menard Singletary s. Otis A. Singletary Sr., who may be the Otis on Page 37, SC Book.

So far as I have heard, in over a year there has been no expression of activity, or intent, from Winston-Salem. While this is regrettable, it is not remediable by us. As some consideration should be given to preserving the data some of us have accumulated, should CSA bulletins in the future bring up to date lines not extended in the SC Book? Please let us have your expressions of opinion on this. If there is enough interest in this type of material, a future Bulletin will give instructions as to content, form, and selection of such material to be submitted by members.

Herewith is a Stack of information furnished by Mr. Lester Dunham, who is a descendant of Jonathan Singletary or Dunham (1639-c.1703) who was a son of Richard and Susanna (Cook) Singletary that went to New Jersey in 1670 with his wife Mary Blumfield, and changed the name to Dunham (Donham)

In a Contract, dated June 8, 1670, between Jonathan Dunham alias Singletary and the Towne of Woodbridge, N. J., he agrees to erect a Grist Mill, the first in this part of the country, he was granted 213 acres of land as a bonus for erecting the Mill. At the same time he built his home which was of brick, said to have been used as ballast on ships sailing from Holland. It was considered a mansion and the only one in the area built of brick. It still stands and is presently the Rectory of Trinity Episcopal Church. One of his original millstones has been preserved in an island of the circular drive, opposite the entrance to the Rectory, on a concrete base with a bronze tablet affixed thereto. The Town of Woodbridge on October 5, 1969 unveiled a monument to his memory as one of the Town's Outstanding Citizens. He had served on many of the most important governmental and church positions as well as a member of The Assembly Under the Proprietary Government in 1673 and 1701, representing the Woodbridge District at East Jersey, under Governor Carteret. He died about 1703. All of his descendants are shown in the records as Dunham or Donham. Many of them used the name Donham.
