

"A List of the Mob Raitously Assembled together in Bladen County, October 13 1773"

This record was temporarily stored with the Bladen County Miscellaneous Records from ca. 1959 to November 1988. It has now been restored to its original location in the General Assembly Session Records, Colonial (Box 7, folder 26, "Petitions rejected, tabled, or not acted on.") The list apparently accompanied a petition (now missing) from Archibald McKissock, presented to the December 1773 Assembly concerning a number of free Negroes and mulattoes annoying the inhabitants of Bladen County.
