 makes the following declaration in order to obtain the pension under the provisions of an act entitled "An act to amend  
 Chapter 198 of the Laws of 1889, for the relief of certain Confederate Soldiers and Widows," ratified March 2, 1901; that she is  
 the widow of the late \_\_\_\_\_  
 who enlisted in Co. G, \_\_\_\_\_ 48 Reg. N. C. State Troops, on or about the 1st day of  
August, 1862, to serve in the armies of the late Confederate States.  
 She further states that she was married to said Soldier or Sailor before the first day of April, 1865, and has never re-married;  
 that she is, and has been for twelve months immediately preceding this Application for Pension, a bona fide resident of North  
 Carolina; that she holds no office under the United States or under any State or County, from which she is receiving the sum of  
 three hundred dollars as fees or as salary annually; that she is not worth in her own right, or the right of her late husband,  
 property at its assessed value for taxation to the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500), nor has she disposed of property of such  
 value by gift or voluntary conveyance since the 11th of March, 1885.
