and confirm this my last Will and testament  
That is first of all I bequeath my soul to god  
that gave it and my body to the earth to be in-  
terred in decent Christian burial at the discretion  
of my friends and as touching such worldly  
estate as it shall please god to bless me with I  
give and bequeath my whole estate goods and  
Chattels lands and tenements to my wife Elizabeth  
Johnson during her natural life and at her  
death to my still daughter Elizabeth Blackwell.

And I hereby appoint and ordain my wife  
Elizabeth Johnson sole Executrix of this my  
last will and testament
