I Solomon Johnson of the County of Bladen and State of North Carolina. being sick and weak but of sound mind and memory thank be to god. calling to mind the uncertainty of my body and knowing that it is appointed unto all men once to die. do hereby make and confirm this my last Will and testament that is first of all I bequeath my Soul to God that gave it. and my body to the earth to be interred in decent Christian burial. at the discretion of my friends and as touching such worldly estate as it hath pleased god to bless our units I give and bequeath my whole estate goods and Charters lands and tenements. to my wife Elizabeth Johnson. during her natural life and at her death to my sole daughter Elizabeth Blackmer.

And I hereby appoint and ordain my wife Elizabeth Johnson. sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament
