

ALBUM OF ANNIE NIXON CUTRELL BENSON 11/18/1882-12/8/1957

MRS. ANNIE C. BENSON OF FAIRFIELD SUCCUMBS

Funeral services for Mrs. Annie C. Benson, 74, of Fairfield, who died in Tayloe Hospital in Washington Sunday afternoon after a short illness, were held from the Fairfield Methodist Church Tuesday at 11 a.m., conducted by the Rev. Robert Bundy. Burial was in the Fairfield Cemetery.

The widow of the late J. M. Benson, she was born at Fairfield November 18, 1883, daughter of the late W. B. and Jane E. Ward Nixon. She was a member of the Fairfield Methodist Church.

Surviving are: three daughters Mrs. Leland Carawan of Key West, Fla., Mrs. A. A. Jessie of Oakland, Calif., and Mrs. John R Swindell of Swan Quarter; one son Guy R. Cuthrell of Tampa, Fla. four step-daughters, Mrs. Guy Dunshee of Pantego, Mrs. Clinton Paul of Norfolk, Va., Mrs. Jack Simpkins of Newport News, Va. and Mrs. Charlie King of Rich mond, Va.; two step-sons, Charles Benson and John Benson, both of Pantego; two sisters, Mrs. U. B Fisher of Swan Quarter and Mrs L. L. Lyon of Tampa, Fla.; and two brothers, Julian C. Nixon of Bayside, Va., and W. B. Nixon of Fairfield.

After long sickness Mr. J. S. Cutrell was called home to his reward July 12, about 7 o'clock. Previously he had two light strokes and the last one took him out in sudden death. For years he belonged to the Methodist church, at one time being a steward of the church. For a number of years—in fact, until he became unable—he kept store. He was a faithful father and husband, a good citizen and a man with many friends. He leaves to mourn his going his mother, three brothers and one sister, a widow and four children; also a host of friends and relatives.

The funeral services were conducted by Rev. Mr. Minga, pastor of the Methodist church, as-

sisted by Rev. E. R. Stewart of the Baptist church and Rev. Roe Harris of the Christian church. The Masons held services over his body at the grave. He was born on September 13, 1869, being almost 60 years of age.
