Ellis my wife Inhabitants of the County of Bath in the State of North Carolina for and in consideration of thirty five pounds current money paid to sell, alien, make over and assign unto Capt Nicholas Thomas Jones his heirs or assigns all our right, title, and interest to our husbands and joint sons of Land lying and being on the west side of a creek called the Little River on the south side of the mouth of the said creek on the north side of the River extending to an acre, as of Capt Nicholas Smith as appears upon Records, with all houses and other things thereunto in any way and all other appurtenances thereto belonging in full and ample manner warranting the said Land unto the said Capt Nicholas Thomas Jones and his heirs and assigns forever my heirs or assigns to have and to hold the said piece of Land for ever, as witness our hands and seals this 10th Day of August anno domini 1788.
