Know all men that I Thomas Penhew do by these presents make known that upon an Entry of Land by me made ye 6<sup>th</sup> of July anno Domini 1708 as appears upon Records called Writs and Grants;

37. Know all men that on the 5<sup>th</sup> Day of November of ye 10<sup>th</sup> year of our said late  
William King of England &c. came from 1702 between Stephen Swetnam of Middlesex  
in Westchester Co. of ye one Part, and Thomas Penhew of Carolina Planter of  
ye other Part, with which they and Stephen Swetnam both and by their Presents do here  
and put himself and Apprentice and servant to ye sd Thomas, to serve him or his  
assignes in ye Plantation of Carolina, beyond ye seas for ye space of four years next  
traininge annual of ye sd servant in ye sd Plantation, and do hereby covenant  
to, with and trusty to serve his sd master, or his lawfull assignes in ye sd Plan-  
tation for and during ye sd Terme according to ye Law and Customes of ye sd  
Plantation; and doth farther declare and covenant, yt he ye sd servant, at ye  
time of ye expiring hereof, is of ye age of 21 years, a single Person, and no contracter  
or contracted servant to any other Person or Persons; and ye sd master for himself  
his ex<sup>ors</sup> assignes, in consideration thereof, doth hereby covenant, promise, and agree to  
and with his sd servant yt he ye sd master or his assignes shall and will at his  
and thurs own proper costs and charges, with ut convenient speed they may carry  
or carry, or cause to be carried & conveyed over unto his Plantation, his sd servant  
and new broodpath and during the sd Voyage and also during the sd Terme, and  
at the end thereof; shall and will at ye like costs and charges provide for and allow  
his sd servant all necessary clothes, meat, drink, washing, lodging and other neces-  
sary fit and convenient for him, according to ye customes of ye Plantation and  
as other servants are in such Cases provided for and allowed.

In witness whereof ye sd Parties have hereunto sett their hands and seals  
ye Day and Year above-mentioned.

And as it is to be seen by the above-mentioned Stephen Swetnam came be-  
fore me Thomas Bell appointed of sd Cornwall ye Day and Year above-  
written, and declared himself to be a single Person, no contracter or contracted servant, to  
any Person or Persons to be of ye age of 21 years, and to be desirous to serve ye above-mentioned  
Thomas Penhew four years according to ye tenour of ye indenture above-written  
all which he is registered in ye office for ye purpose appointed by Letters Patentes in wit-  
ness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand and seal this 19<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1718.
