Know all men by these Presents that I Cornelius Benington on the County of Allamakee have assigned, retained, made and in my stead give Power by these Presents put and constituted my trusty and well-beloved friend Thomas Upper of Pamlico in the County of Bath to be my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, and to my use to take, ask, sue for, lay, receive, recover and receive of James Wild in the County of Bath in behalf of price or the value in skins which are now due unto me by this Indian what so ever; giving and granting unto my said Attorney my full power and authority in and about the premises and upon receipt of any such Bats or skins of money if so said, acquitances, or other discharges, for me and in my name to make seal and deliver of these acts and to recover in Law for the recovery of all or any suits for me and in my name, if I were there in my own Person present and what ever my attorney shall lawful do or cause to be done in or about the Execution of the Premises by virtue of these Presents, this first Day of July 1702.
