The petitioner states, that she is the widow of Jno Day, Sr, late of this county, who diede Intestate, seized & possessed of a tract of land in said county on the waters of Tar River adjoining the lands of Jaas Webb, \_\_\_\_\_, containing about 555 acres. In abeyance to an order of Court December Term 1825 directed to the Shff Commanding him to Summons a Jury of Lawful men to lay off and allot to Barbary Day Widow of John Day Sr Decd one third part of the Land which the said John Day Senr died seized and possessed of We the undersigned Jurors after having been duly Summonsed and Sworn by the Shff aforesaid did on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of January AD 1826 procead to the Execution of the same in manner & form as follows to wit Beginning at a stake in the old field running wi? Line chain to the Spring thence south eleven chain & ten links to James Webbs line thence west forty one chain & thirty seven links to a stake in Johnstons line thence north on said Johnstons line twenty nine chain & thirty seven links to a Hickory Bush thence east forty seven chains & thirty seven links to a stake in the edge of an old field thence south to the first station Containing by estimation one hundred & Eighty five acres moor or less to her the said Barbary to her the said Barbary Day to have and to hold the aforesaid one hundred & eighty five acres of land aforesaid during her life free from the claim or claims of any other person what ever in testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hand & seals the day and date aforesaid.
