





This indent made this 8th day of May in the year of

Said of the other part witnesseth that the said Mitty Sale
and Edna Johnson for and in consideration of the
sum of ~~two hundred and twenty five~~ ^{two hundred and} dollars
to them in hand paid by the said Constant Gray
the receipt whereof the said Mitty Sale and Edna
Johnson acknowledge them selves there fully
satisfy'd and paid both granted bargain'd and sold
and by these presents doth fully freely & lawfully and
absolutely Grant bargain sell Convey and Con-
firm unto him the said Constant Gray a certain
Tract of Land containing five hundred acres
on both sides of Creech Creek in the sum more or
less beginning at at two Chesnuts running north
one hundred and twenty pole more or less to a pine
then East sixty pole more or less to a white oak
and red oak then north thirty pole more or less
to a post oak and pine then East or Eastwardly
one hundred pole more or less to a red oak then
north twenty five pole more or less to a white oak
on the bank of a branch then East or Eastward
by up said branch not including any of
the bottom or swamps Land on said bra-
nch one hundred pole to a white oak and poplar
then South forty pole more or less to a black
Gum then East twenty five pole to a red oak then
South South two hundred and forty pole to a
white oak then west two hundred and fifty po-
to a white oak then north thirty pole more or less
to a white oak then west or westwardly
eighty pole more or less to the beginning to
gether with every right title privilege & some
matrimonial to the said belonging in any wise

appertaining and the said Melly Sale and Edna Johnson
 both bind them selves their heirs Executors and
 administrators well and truly to warrant and fore
 ever defend the aforesaid premises with all the
 appertainences there unto be longing unto
 him the said Constant Gray his heirs
 and assigns forever free and clear from
 all in Cumberence for blames of any
 person or persons what soever in testimony
 where of they the said Melly Sale and Edna
 Johnson hath hereunto set their hands
 and seals the day and date first above
