State of North Carolina } Court of Pleas & Quarter Sessions
Franklin County. } December Sessions 1866.

To the Worshipful the Justices of the Court of Pleas and Quarter Sessions for the County of Franklin aforesaid:

The petition of Mary A. Williams an infant under the age of twenty-one years, by Solomon Williams, her Guardian, respectfully sheweth, that Wm. A. Williams died sometime in the year 1841, intestate leaving besides other property a large number of Slaves, and leaving her surviving your petitioner his only child and heir at law, and Lucy O. Williams, one of the defendants herein after named, his widow. That letters of administration upon the Estate of the said Wm. A. Williams were by the Worshipful Court duly granted to his widow the said Lucy O. Williams, who has since transacted with James Clenton the other defendant herein after named. Your petitioner further sheweth that there are now in the possession of the said Administratrix about twenty-five Slaves belonging to the estate of her said intestate, which the said Administratrix is prepared and willing to distribute between herself as the widow and sole heir of the said Wm. A. Williams and your petitioner as his only child and next of kin - but inasmuch as your petitioner is an infant of tender years, she is apprehensive that she cannot safely do so without the order and sanction of this Worshipful Court. Is therefore that the said Slaves may be divided between your petitioner and the said Lucy and that 2/3rd thereof may be set apart and allotted to your petitioner, to be possessed and enjoyed by her in fee simple, and that the said James Clenton may answer the promises, may it please your worship to issue a Decree and copy of this petition to be issued directed to the said Lucy and James Clenton commanding them &c. and your petitioner will ever pray, &c.
