This man, whose birth and death are unknown served his South well during the 'War between the States', and at his death, some kind hands, mabe those of his wife, mabe a friends, planted his grave with green grass and rose bushes. There he laid alone, until once again the ground was broken for a fresh grave, and a companion was laid by Soldier Jones side. Whether this companion was a wife or daughter has never been proven, and the grave remains unmarked.

A year ago this month, an overly delighted grandson, found this grave of his long departed Grandad. The grave then shone with a white confederate marker.

And now, today, these two people rest, away from the beaten trail, surrounded by cultivated fields of the new owners, their home housing a negro tenant farmer and his eight children; facing the setting sun, covered by the thick branches of a cottonwood and two storm bent pines, they still belong to that land, their own Southland.
