Imprimis

I bequeath my soul to God who gave it me and my body to the earth its Original indure and certain hopes of the Resurrection to Eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord, and as for my worldly Goods which God has graciously given me, after my worldly Debts are paid, I dispose of in manner and form following (viz)

Item

My will and Desire is that my brother John Long do execute a Deed for that Land which I sold to Nathan Barnes, and the purchase money to be applied to the Discharge of my Debts

Item

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Betsey my Negro Girl Fanny to her and her heirs forever.

Item

If my wife should be with child and have a son I give and bequeath to him my land and plantation whereon I now live to him and his heirs for ever

Item

I leave to my loving wife, all the remaining part of my Estate Real and Personal, during her Natural life or Widowhood, and at her death or Marriage to be equally Divided between my two Daughters Betsey & Marcey and the child which my wife is now pregnant (if any) to them
