in the following Manner and form.

First my will is that my Just Debts be paid and funeral
Expenses discharged

Item I give and bequeath to my son Josiah Green all that tract
of Land that I hold on the North side of Needy Creek and
that Quantity which I allow him to have on the South side
to be laid off according as I have directed, by my last
to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son William Green all the remainder
of Lands that I hold including my Mannor plantation, and all
the Lands adjoining thereunto to him and his heirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Lehartt Duckert
all her goods and Chattels that I have given her in time of
marriage also two Negroes the one named Cesar the other Phillis, and
also my Negro girl named Hannah the three now in possession
