Item I Give and bequeath it as my Desire that as to all my Estate both  
Real and Personal after those Legacies is taken with a tract of  
Land which I hold in Southampton County Virginia may be

kept together by my wife by the Direction of my Executors here  
after mentioned untill such time that the Children under age  
arrive to lawfull age or married, and as soon as any of said  
Children come to that age the said Estate to be Equally divided  
by the direction of said Executors by some Judicious persons  
Indifferently Chosen by said Executors, the first division to be  
made as soon as the first Child come of age or married and so  
on untill the last come to age, that so each Child may have a  
proportionable part or share of Estate to them and their heirs

Item I Give and bequeath to my son William Green all my wearing  
Apparell

Item The Division is to be made only amongst the Children now  
under age.

Item I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Josiah Green  
John Duke and Drury Long my whole and sole Executors to  
this my last will and Testament revoking all making void  
all former Wills by me made and this only to be taken as
