11. Will of John Harris, d11, 1713, Isle of Wight County, Virginia.

I John Harris of the upper part of Isle of Wight County in Virg^a being sick and weak
of body but perfect in mind and memory thanks be to God for it do make this my last
and Testament in manner and form as follows to wit
First and principally I give unto my three daughters Alice Elizabeth and Yabellah
three hundred acres of land lying in the Isle of Wight County at or near Crook
formerly giving me Blough Campbell the abovesaid land I give to my three daughters
and their heirs for ever to be equally between them
I give and bequeath unto my daughter Alice the bed and all the furniture she contains
eye on and one Iron pot and looks on spits and brackets and one Chest with drawers
of pewter and three plates half new half Old and one Cow of six years Old
I give and bequeath unto my two Daughters Elizabeth and Yabellah one bed
lying commonly by me with all furniture as it now stands
I give to my daughter Elizabeth one Iron pot and looks and ten pounds of paper
and three plates and one Cow and one hen for
