in my beloved Committ to Earth to be Decently buried at the Discretion of
my Exors here after named & as touching the Disposition of such Temporal
estate which hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me I
give & Dispose as followeth first I will of my Deeds & Tenure all
charges be paid & discharged. Item I give & bequeath unto my loving
son George Harris my Riding Horse my Gun two and half a do. of lead
and pipe & my son Robert Harris I give & bequeath a pair of
Oxen two Cows & Calves and two Sows & piggs a per
plow & a hand saw and a bed & to my Daughter
I give & bequeath two Cows & Calves a
plow & to my Daughter Sarah Harris I give
I give two powder Dishes (under stick & a iron pot
I give & bequeath my Lads & plantation where on
I live of or Dies a Crook & a to my son the Harris
and fifty Acres of Land & a Last Debel and a Lin
Chackenn a Cow & a pig & a sow & piggs & a
maining to my loving Wife Martha Harris
my loving Wife my sole & sole Exors of this my last Will & Testament
and I do make void & revoke Disannul all other former will & Testam
heretofore made by me W. this hereof I have to this my last Will &
Testament being contained in half a sheet of paper here set to my hand
at this 12 Day December 1719. Signed sealed & given in presence of
George Harris
