of the County of Isle of Wight County being Sick & Weak of
Body but of perfect Mind & Reasoning thank be given to God
Therefore I do hereby declare this my last Will & Testament
Committing my Soul to Almighty God and my Body to the Earth
I Give as for my worldly Estate which hereafter is Expressly Given

Devise and Dispose of the Same in the following Manner as
follows Inprimis I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Joshua Harris
four Piston plates & Two Piston dishes I Give and bequeath
to my Daughter Mary Two Piston Dishes and four Piston Plates
I Give and bequeath to the Child that my wife now goes with
her (be it Boy or Girl) Two Piston Dishes four Piston Plates, I Give
I Give five to my Son Joshua One Piston Dish and one Piston
Plate more than One Gun and one pair of Pistols with Holsters I
