I Anthony Bourdeaux of the County of Newhanover & Province of North Carolina being very sick & weak be given unto God, Calling unto me knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my Last will & Testament that is to say first of all I give and recommend my soul in to the hand of the Almighty God that gave it me & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but as the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, and as touching such worldly Estate which I have with in has blessed God to bestow on this Life I give demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form: First, I give & bequeath to my well beloved wife Priscilla Bourdeaux the third part of all my my house & plantation & all my own natural Life or widow hood, & Anthony the one half of my Land after his Mothers decease or widowhood the other half of the said Land that is one Shilling Sterling at that tract of Land Laying the waste between them two I give & bequeath and I gave a certain tract of Land side of Rockfords Creek and after the death of my Estate to be appraised and divided between my youngest daughter Ann Bourdeaux in proportion with the 3 of my sons & the Remainder of my Estate to be equally divided between 3 of my sons according to their several disadvantages in the Land before mentioned. & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & every other former Testaments wills Legacies bequests & executors & confirmings thereof no other to be my Last will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this thirteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & sixty six
