County single woman that she the said Sarah Truitt  
is now with child by him the said Langley & Pinner  
which child when born will be a bastard of therefore the said  
Langley & Pinner shall personally appear before the justices  
of the Court of pleas & Quarter Sessions to be holden for the aforesaid  
County of Tyrell at Columbus on the fourth Monday July  
next then & there to abide by & perform what shall then be  
enjoined by said Court concerning the premises of then the above  
written recognizance shall be void
