Boadwell & sons, Clerk. are held and firmly bound unto the

Judges of the County aforesaid in the sum of five hundred dollars
to be paid to the said Judges on their successors in office, to which
payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and our
heirs and respective heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and
severally firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated the
25 day of January 1830.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas
the above bounden Ruben Cahoon stand charged according to
law with being the father of a bastard child of which Polly

Blake has lately been delivered; now if the said Polly
Ruben Cahoon his heirs, executors, admin of any of them do and
shall from time to time and at all times hereafter acquit, discharge
and leave harmless the overseers of the poor and inhabitants of the
County aforesaid from all cost, charge and trouble whatsoever
for and by reason of the birth, maintenance of and bringing
up of said child and of and from all other suits, charges and
demands whatsoever touching and concerning the same, then the
above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force
and virtue.
